Want to Weave like RAYA? Learn to motivate speed and make entries from All Angles




Wendy MacLellan has been training and competing in Agility since 1995. Wendy has trained several dogs over the years her first was Zeus who won the BC Top Agility Dog cup in 1997 and also ranked as high as #2 in Canada with a number of Regional and National placements before his retirement in 2002. Raya, her second dog, has been on the CKC Canadian Agility Team in 2004 and 2005 and completed the Clean Run Ultimate 60 Weave Pole Challenge completing in 13.81 secs! (on dirt). Kaizen her young Kelpie is three years old with his ATCHC traveled to Norway 2007 and now to Finland September 2008 for the FCI World's with the CAT. Wendy has used her own modified weave training method, which has worked well with all her Agility dogs. Her dogs can find their own weave pole entry at high speeds from all angles because of her solid foundation in weave pole training. The dogs learn how to weave independent of the handler or their positioning.

Wendy's believes this seminar will train or re-train dogs and has included privates for the afternoon to help handlers with specific weave pole issues such as high speed entries, popping poles or working gamble weaves.

All money raised from the clinic and private sessions will be donated to the CKC Canadian Agility Team (CAT) to help with their fundraising efforts to send CAT to Finland in Sept 2008 to compete in the FCI Agility World Championships.

WEAVE POLE TRAINING CLINIC (morning session) *LIMITED TO 10 working spots

This workshop is good for those learning to train new starters dogs, or for a new technique for your future agility dog. Dogs in working spots must be at least 12 months of age.

-  The clinic will be 2 hrs max. in length
-  Max 10 dog Working spots - Working spots are suitable for Starters dogs
-  Unlimited auditing -

What you will learn: Wendy M's modified weave pole-training method, theory, obstacle entry, and obstacle performance. Working dogs will be put through drills with Wendy giving you helpful pointers to correct style, and application of her theory and training method.

RETRAINING / PRIVATES (Afternoon pre-scheduled appointments)

Privates are great way to work one on one with your dog, while Wendy M. helps you apply her modified weave pole training method to help correct your current weave pole performance. Privates are for dogs that are working at the Advanced/Masters Level who have specific issues with weave pole performance.

*** It would be preferable that people booking privates sessions, audit the weave pole training workshop, to familiarize yourself with Wendy's unique technique, but is not required.

Privates are booked at 20 min. in length; your specific issues are addressed on a one on one basis. Times will be pre-scheduled with 5 minutes between each session for instructor break. Please do your best to arrive on time for your appointment.
